How to complete the form so you get the subjects you wish to study in 2019.

- Students must choose at least 1 elective from each learning area over the year, i.e. Blue, Red, Green, and Orange.
- All students must complete a compulsory **Instrumental Music.**
- All students must complete one semester of either **Chinese, Japanese or Indonesian.**
- Choose 2 subjects per term, one from line 2 and one from line 4.
- Place 1 next to your first preference and 2 next to your second preference for each line, each term.
- There may be a cost associated with some subjects, so please refer to the handbook or ask your teacher what cost is involved in your choices.
