Year 11 Biology

FOGG DAM AND ADELAIDE RIVER CATCHMENT FIELD TRIP

Last week, the Year 11 Biology students visited the wetlands at Fogg Dam as part of their Ecology Unit for this term. Students were able to conduct surveys and collect data to assist with their research assignment on the importance of wetlands. This field trip offered students the opportunity to learn what is involved in on-ground management and observe plant and animal communities occurring in natural settings. Students were also able to observe and appreciate the diversity and complexity of the local ecosystem, the interaction among living organisms, the interaction between organisms and their immediate environments, the various stages of ecological succession, how individual organisms and populations respond to environmental stress which was evident with the low levels of water in the system at the moment, and how communities respond to various types and intensities of disturbance such as the wildfire that had gone through the area very recently. Students had an enjoyable day and were extremely lucky to have missed the storm which they were welcomed with upon their return.
