

Michelle is solely responsible for the opening of the uniform shop, and wishes to advise that the opening hours for Term 4 will be as follows:


Monday: 8:15am to 10:15am

# MacKillop Japan Trip 19th Sep-4th Oct 2017



#### Dear Parent I Guardian,

Over the past four years MacKillop Catholic College has provided students with one to one laptops. This program was possible due to a combination of Federal Government Funding under the Digital Education Revolution and through loans paid by the College. This government funding ceased in 2013 with no promise of any additional funding into the future. The following letter details our way forward over the next two years.

MacKillop Catholic College is presently implementing a Bring Your Own Laptop (BYOL) program for all Year 7-12 students. In 2016, Year 9-12 students had the opportunity to bring their own laptops, with an option for students to borrow a laptop, while Year 7 and 8 students were allocated a College laptop and in 2017 the program will cover Years 7-12.

In 2017, Parents/guardians have the opportunity to borrow a College laptop, if they prefer this option to BYOL. In 2017 the College laptops will be given to students through a College Laptop registration form. There are only a limited number of College laptops and it will be given based on a priority registration list. The registered applicants will receive the device in the second week of Term 1, once they make the laptop levy payment. ### For BYOL devices please note the following points:

Lenovo laptops are the NTSCHOOLS approved laptops. Parents and or guardians can buy Lenovo laptops from:

- Territory Technology Solutions, Winnellie; or,
- Your preferred outlet,

We recommend laptops with the following specifications:

- RAM minimum 4GB;
- Wireless;
- Good processor i5 or above is a good option; and,
- 3 years ext. product care warranty including battery.

To be noted - ADP: Accidental damage will need to be covered by parents under personal contents insurance. Further to this some vendors provide accidental damage cover; however, this needs to be discussed with each vendor.

All students on BYOL have the option to get the laptops reimaged so as to obtain access to the ntschools network. If the laptops are not reimaged, students will connect only to ntschools guest network. At any point in time, students may rent a College laptop while their laptop is under repair for a charge of \$20/week.

The College laptop levy will be paid before collecting the laptop.

- a. College borrowed laptop: Levy -\$280 per year
- b. BYOL levy: \$110 per year

It is important to note that when bringing your own laptops the Laptop Levy for one year (\$110) covers free MS Office Package, antivirus software, access to the network, and access to the internet.

Our College will provide technical support ONLY for network connection issues, wireless and/or internet access at the College for BYOL laptops.






