Sister School Treaty with Hakata

Eyes to the world opened

TWO schools, one in Palmerston and another 5464km away in Japan's Fukuoka Pre fecture, signed a sister school treaty last week.

MacKillop Catholic College principal Lauretta Graham said it was the first sister school relationship their school had

ever entered into. "It's some thing that will open the worlds of the children," Ms Graham

MacKillop teaches three modern languages, including

Japanese. "It's important for our students to make the cultural connections, and not just learn from the textbooks," Ms Graham said.

Hakata deputy principal Minoru Uchio said last Monday's sister school treaty ceremony "cemented" the relationship between the two schools

He said the next step was

for students to start emailing each other, to help the Japa nese students improve their English, and the Australian students to tweak their Japanese. Last week's trip was Mr

Uchio's first time in Darwin. and said his highlight was meeting the MacKillop Catholic College students

"It's very hot," he said.

"(Darwin) is better than expected, the nature is very beautiful." Mr Uchio said in Japan,

there was a trend for schools to develop sister school re-

lationships around the globe. Hakata has five sister schools, including its newest relationship with MacKillop Catholic College.

Spread word to Japan

JAPANESE travellers love Australia but not enough tourists visit the NT, says Manyou Travel (My Travel) CEO Takatsugu Nishiyama.

"Most people only know about the east coast," Mr Nishiyama said.

"I would like to bring more people to Darwin ... it is a beautiful place."

My Travel is a travel company based in Japan's Fukuoka Prefecture which connects Japanese travellers with cities around the world.

Mr Nishiyama said he want-

ed to promote NT barramundi fishing tours, rock climbing, jumping croc tours, nature walks and Kakadu National Park to those interested in travelling to Australia.

In the future Mr Nishivama said he wanted to open a My Travel office in Darwin to promote the Territory.

"Uluru is quite famous," Mr Nishiyama said. "The other 99 per cent of

the NT is not well known."

According to figures from Tourism Research Australia, in the year ending March 2016, 21,000 Japanese travellers ventured to the NT.

This figure was up 9.1 per cent on March 2015's figures. In the same period, spending by Japanese tourists almost doubled, leaping from \$19 million in the year ending March 2015 to \$28 million in the year ending March 2016.


Book Week - Week 9
