Dear Members of MacKillop Catholic College Community,

Over the past weeks my leadership team and I have had the delightful experience of conducting dozens of enrolment interviews for 2014. Speaking with these young people and their families has been an absolute pleasure. I have been inspired by their desire to embrace Catholic Education at MacKillop Catholic College. These interviews have been a time to celebrate and share the wonderful story of their lives though their primary years and hear their aspirations for education through to year 12 and beyond.

In 2012, we educated 89 students comprising of years 7 through to 9, and this year we have 220 students through to year 10. In 2014, we confidently predict well over 300 students. Positive growth such as this enables us to offer all subjects that students desire and with these student numbers the opportunities to further enhance extra curricula programs is a reality.

- that follow 'best practice' in the provision of safe and secure school environments that recognise they are part of a community of schools united in a common vision.


Catholic Education at MacKillop is unfolding new opportunities for 2014 for all involved in our College. Come "share the story".
