#### Dear Families,

This week (August 27-28) the Church celebrates the consecutive feast days of St Monica and St Augustine. These two saints, although having lived in the 4th century in Hippo (Northern Africa) and later in Milan Italy, are somewhat relatable to the state Christianity finds itself in the 21st century.

Although Monica, the mother of Augustine, was a devout Catholic, Augustine was from a young age heavily influenced by his father and much of his society at that time to embrace a life of hedonism; that is to engage

in the constant pursuit of pleasure and sensually self-indulgent practices. In his book, 'The Confessions', written after his extraordinary conversion to Catholicism, Augustine elaborates upon what his life consisted of and confesses rather explicitly to what these "sensual" pursuits were.

Augustine was an extremely gifted academic and and yet due to his lifestyle, although he had considered the possibility of Christianity, his heart was hardened to accepting Jesus as his Lord and God and he found himself consistently filled with discontentment. It took his mother Monica years of constant prayer and sacrifice for her son, who eventually, in a fascinating series of events, submitted his entire life to God and found the peace he was searching for.

In his personal reflections, Augustine relates that although his sensual pursuits brought some temporary pleasure, nothing he ever indulged in ever gave him a proper or lasting contentment; for he became convicted that God "had made us for himself and our heart is restless until it finds its rest in him" (Confessions). Augustine discovered that one's happiness and ultimate peace could only be possible in and through a relationship with Jesus, the 'Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6).

Saint Monica's and Augustine's stories are relatable to Christianity in the modern world, primarily because for many, like the people of their era, the pursuit of pleasure has been placed

above a visible relationship with God. In other words, it appears that in our society, we have created many avenues for an acceptable practice of self-indulgence, however, there doesn't seem to be a correlating level of visible self-contentment. How do we discover peace in our hearts and how would these two saints respond to that question?

St Monica and St Augustine, pray for us.


