

## **Summary Highlights MCC Board AGM & Board Meeting March 2023**

- Current enrolments sit at 702 students, with new enrolments still being received.
- The College has recruited 26 new staff for 2023, inclusive of 15 new teachers.
- The perimeter fence project has been completed, and has stopped frequent breakins. Students have reported feeling safer in the College.
- NAPLAN Testing has commenced for Year 7 & 9 students.
- 2023 Annual Improvement Plan has been finalised.
- Students have provided positive feedback to staff regarding the new uniform and school bags.
- Year 12 Retreat was recently held and was very successful. Year 8 Retreat will be held next week.
- The RTO will be transitioning from MacKillop to become a shared CENT resource with the other 18 Catholic Schools in the NT over the coming year.
