Small Motors Skillset

With this skillset you will learn how to diagnose and repair small engine motors, operate machinery in a correct and safe manner as well as functioning safely and efficiently in a workshop.

Units of Competency

A total of three (3) units to be completed:

AHCMOM204	Undertake operational maintenance of machinery
AHCMOM203	Operate basic machinery and equipment
TLID0020	Shift materials safely using manual handling methods

Delivery

Duration: The course will run for one term, timetabled from 8.30 – 3pm one day per week.

Delivery Mode: Classroom based tasks and assessments and workplace assessments, with possible excursions. Assessment and the relevant resources/guides are provided.

Prerequisites: Nil.

Location: At MacKillop Catholic College training room; vocational workplace and sites of interest.

PPE: Supply your own clothing: shorts or long trousers, short or long-sleeved hi-vis shirt, gloves and sturdy boots.

Cost: There is no course cost for school students; adults to contact the office for further information.
